COVID-19 specific notice update

A notice to all involved in Leinster Badminton

As a follow on to our previous press release, dated 14.03.2020 and due to the continued developments around this Covid-19 outbreak and today's announcement by our Taoiseach, Leo Varadkar, the Badminton centres at Baldoyle and Terenure belonging to Leinster Badminton, will remain closed until April 19th 2020. This also extends to 'all sports events', as stated by the Irish government today.

We believe this action to be in-line with that of the directive by the government's announcement today. Therefore, the centres will be closed for all public use until April 19th at a minimum. This action will be reviewed by the Leinster Executive Committee before this date of April 19th and an announcement through our various media outlets will be made.

Leinster Badminton wish to apologise to all our clubs, participants, staff, volunteers and any other person or party affected by this action, but we hope that everyone can appreciate that this is being done for the safety of all involved.

Please note that the HSE are the ultimate guide for us all in this unprecedented matter.

Coronavirus COVID-19

How to Prevent

- Wash**
your hands well and often to avoid contamination

- Clean**
and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces
- Stop**
shaking hands or hugging when saying hello or greeting other people
- Distance**
yourself at least 2 metres (6 feet) away from other people, especially those who might be unwell
