## Dick O'Rafferty

Leinster Badminton remembers Dick as a great player, volunteer, manager, archivist and thorough gentleman.

As a player, he won many honours, including an Irish club championship, was a multiple Leinster champion and represented Leinster many times.

As a coach, he concentrated on developing young Leinster players and coached an Irish U18 team to win the Finlandia Cup.

As an administrator he served on the Executive Committee of the Branch, as President and later as a Trustee, and finally as General Secretary.

Dick's other enduring legacy to badminton is as Curator and Trustee of Badminton Museum Ireland (BMI). He devoted enormous enthusiasm and energy to sourcing and assembling artefacts, trophies, publications, photographs and records, now located at the Baldoyle Badminton Centre.

#### Joe Buckley

Joe was a lifelong stalwart of Leinster Badminton. He was very popular and everyone knew him or of him. He played Badminton for Garda/Avondale and Mount Pleasant.

He served on the Leagues and Cups Committee as Chairman for over 25 years, also served on the Leinster Executive Committee and was active for a number of years on the Midland Bar Committee. Joe was awarded Honorary Life Member membership for his contribution to Leinster Branch. Joe was very sociable and always supported Branch events and regularly attended Premier League Games.

#### Eileen McCormack

Eileen spent many years closely involved with Baldoyle Badminton Centre, the Over 35's League, her club KADCA and yet, still found even more time to chair the Executive and serve on a BI subcommittee.

Eileen was instrumental in implementing the Children Safeguarding Document back many years which showed Badminton's commitment to Child Protection well before it became mandatory.

To all their families thank you for allowing them to give so generously of their time to the Branch.
