The County Affairs Committee (C.A.C) ran its three competitions this season for the first time in three years.

The individual championship took place in December and were not very well represented by a lot of the Counties, but the event went well but was enjoyed by all who took part (see Organiser PO 'Connells report in Appendix 1).

The Leinster Inter County finals took place in February and was the best supported of all events by the counties. All Grades were played except grade1 which was disappointing.
