



## **Leinster Primary Schools Badminton**

On February 1st, 2024, Badminton Ireland are delighted to present the Annual Leinster Schools Badminton finals in Baldoyle Badminton Centre which will act as a qualifier for the All-Ireland Primary Schools Competition. The deadline for schools to complete their registration is **Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> December** after which no more forms will be accepted.

General information on the event is as follows:

- 1. There is a limit on the total number of teams entered per gender, so please submit your team entry form promptly.
- 2. Each team consists of 4 players and each player plays 1 level doubles. Each game is 1 set to 21 with no setting.
- 3. All players on a team must be attending the same Primary School.
- 4. Each child will receive a medal.
- 5. Winners, Runners-up, and Semi-Finalists from Leinster get put forward to All-Ireland Primary Schools Final.
- 6. If a team from Leinster can't attend the All-Ireland Finals, the province can nominate a team to replace the team that can't attend.
- 7. Each team will be seeded for All Ireland Finals by their finishing position at the Provincial qualifier.
- 8. Supervision must be provided by Teachers, or designated persons, from schools at all times.

## Requirement to enter:

It is a requirement for schools to be eligible to participate, they must be affiliated with Badminton Ireland prior to the start of the competition, this can be completed through the link attached- <u>Please click on the link here to affiliate your School for the</u>

## Fee:

The **School Affiliation Fee for all schools is €15** which can be paid through Bank Transfer, PayPal, or Cheque (you will be redirected to 'Pay Badminton Ireland' page upon completing of Affiliation Form).
