

## Senior tournament report 2023-2024

The Autumn Open took place in Whitehall Road on September 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup>; 2023 .unlike other seasons, this was the first ranking event of the year as the Mount Pleasant Open was moved to later in the season. It was a very successful event – with 109 players playing 99 matches across two days. There were some fabulous games, but the standout performance was David Walsh who won the treble. It was also great to see more entries in the Women's singles & Doubles than previous years.
