



Youth Activities Committee AGM Report 2025

The Youth Activities Committee is a sub-committee of the Leinster Executive Committee, and its main objectives are to increase juvenile participation in Leinster, and to promote & develop badminton at all levels.

The committee, with the assistance of Leinster Branch staff, is responsible for running Ranked and Non-ranked Tournaments, Leinster Intercounty Competitions, Leinster Interleague Competitions, Leinster Squads, Leinster Representative Team competitions and Leinster Schools Finals.

The juvenile calendar runs from January to December and therefore, most of the information provided in this report relates to the 2024 juvenile season. At the time of writing, several tournaments, Leinster Intercounty finals, Leinster Schools finals and Leinster representative team events for 2025 have been held.

2024 Leinster Intercounty Finals

Leinster Intercounty Finals were held at U13, U15, U17 and U19 age groups. As normal, the Leinster Youth Activities Committee provided t-shirts to all the County teams. The winner of Division One in each age group represented Leinster at BI's All-Ireland Intercounty Finals.

We were delighted to welcome Laois and Wexford back to the competition after a significant absence.

2024 Leinster Schools Finals

2024 Leinster Juvenile Tournaments

Ranked Tournaments

The Leinster juvenile ranked tournaments continue to grow. In 2024, there were 129 entries in the Leinster Yonex U15/U19 Open which was in increase of 50% in entries compared to 2023. The entry has grown to 156 entries in the Leinster Yonex U15/U19 Open in 2025. The Leinster Yonex U13/U17 Open had 167 entries in 2024 which is slightly larger than the 166 entries in 2023. In 2025, the Leinster Yonex U13/U17 Open has grown to 192 entries. Due to increasing numbers of entries, it is now necessary to use both Terenure and Baldoyle Badminton Centres for the Juvenile ranked tournaments. Thanks go to Jean Kelly, Liza O'Rourke, Brian Kelly, Muriel Moles, Shanthini Chandra for running the ranked tournaments. Thanks also go to the Court Officials Group for providing referees and umpires for our events.

Festival of Tournaments

This set of tournaments continues to grow from strength to strength. The tournaments are for club players living and playing in Leinster and are closed to Leinster and National squad players. YACs are delighted that we have now achieved our target to have half the tournaments held outside Dublin. In addition to the WestsideFest in Kildare, the DecemberFest was held in Navan and the CarlowFest was held in Carlow. Many thanks go to Margaret Fallon, Martin Sheridan and Marton O'Hanlon and their teams of volunteers for running the Fests in their home Counties. Thanks go to Jean Kelly, Grainne Kinnerk, Gordon Chambers and Joe Byrne for running the Fests in Dublin.

The YACs also run the Leinster Yonex Christmas Close from 27-29th December every year and this tournament also continues to grow.

2024 Leinster Squads and Representative Teams

The Leinster squads are run by our volunteer Managers and our Coaches, and many thanks go to this group for the ongoing work they do with our talented young players. In addition to our Head Coaches for each squad we have a panel of experienced coaches who also coach at the squad sessions.

There are two sets of team competitions for Leinster juvenile teams. The first set occurs in the first half of the year and consists of the U14 Celtic Challenge, the U16 Celtic Challenge and the U18 Intercounty Tournament in Nottingham, also known as "Notts". The second set occurs in the Autumn and consists of the U11 annual friendly match versus Alpha, and the three Interprovincial competitions at U13, U15 and U17.

The team competitions continue to be hugely popular with Leinster juvenile players. The competition to make these teams is fierce, and a robust set of criteria is published on the Leinster Badminton website to ensure that the selection process used is transparent and fair. To join a Leinster squad, all parents/guardians are required to return a consent form for their player which covers several items, including an acknowledgement that selection criteria have been read and understood.

2024 U11 Friendly match vs Alpha

This continues to be a highly valued event for introducing younger players to the enjoyment of team events. Managed by Grainne Kinnerk, and coached by Sumesh Tharian, the players participated in four squads in the Autumn and then played a Challenge match against a team from Alpha.

An U11 Blitz was held in September 2011, and all players who attended the Blitz were invited to attend the U11 squads. As this is a Development Squad, all players are encouraged to play the Fest tournaments.







2024 U14 Celtic Challenge

Challenges

- The Youth Activities Committee is a voluntary committee and depends upon a small number of highly dedicated and hard-working volunteers. A Development plan is being finalised and will need the full support of the Leinster Executive Committee to be brought fully to fruition.
- The rising cost of travel is an issue for all, and this is no different for the Youth Activities
 Committee. Fortunately, due to the healthy financial position of Leinster Badminton, the
 YACs would hope to continue to receive financial support from the Executive Committee to
 allow these team trips to continue.
- We are extremely fortunate to have several top coaches working with our squads. However,
 we still need more coaches to be able to provide more opportunity for more players. Our
 new Development Plan aims to continue to develop coaches across the province that will
 play invaluable roles in Provincial and County activities.
- Access to Baldoyle and Terenure Badminton Centres: we need to continue to have access to both Leinster Branch centres to continue our Development Activity. As demand has increased for courts, we have not been able to access the courts as much as we want to. We feel that this is of strategic importance for the Branch and all efforts should be made to ensure that Leinster Youth Development activities are prioritised for access to courts in both Leinster Branch centres.
- The "new" juvenile calendar from January to December continues to prove to be extremely challenging, particularly as the senior calendar has not changed and continues to run from September to April/May. We have found January to April to be far too heavily loaded with Juvenile events which has made it extremely difficult to fit all of competitions and squads into the season. The new season began on the 1st January and we have had to play all schools competitions, all intercounty competitions, both the U13/U17 Leinster Open and the U15/U19 Leinster Open, the Interpros, the U18 ICT, and the U14 and U16 Celtic Challenge by the end of April. With the exception of the Fests in the Autumn and the Christmas Close, there are no further competitions to be held by Leinster until after January 1st 2026.





Conclusion

2024 was a phenomenally successful year for Leinster's Youth Activities Committee. Growth across all competitions is extremely healthy. The juvenile representative teams brought home six wins across all competitions played.
