

Notice is hereby given that a Special General Meeting of the Leinster Branch Council will take place on:

Wednesday July 16th, 2025, at 8pm in Baldoyle Badminton Centre.

The Executive Committee in accordance with the Rules of the Branch will seek approval to spend in excess of the €50k limit which is laid down in the Rules of the Branch. This proposal requires prior approval from the Council. The expenditure is to improve facilities for players at all levels and will be part refunded from Grants awarded to Leinster Branch , under the Sports Capital Programme.

1. The purpose of the Expenditure is to:

Replace floor surfaces in Baldoyle, making them safer for players and more accessible for para-athletes.

Reduce energy costs in both centres, by installing led lighting.

Set up a gym in Baldoyle.

Improve facilities for inclusive badminton in both centres with the addition of disability toilets, disabled doors (in both), installation of a lift (Baldoyle) and a ramp (Terenure).

Voting

Members will be asked to vote on this proposal at the Special General meeting detailed above. Voting will take place by ballot.
