Centre is almost at full capacity with little room for expanding our offering.

Betty and the staff at Whitehall Road have a real challenge with this limited capacity for the evolving demands from our members.

We have therefore looked at expanding the centre and have had meetings with an Architect and Planning consultant with a view to seeking planning permission to develop the site and add 5 more courts to the venue.

### **Hall:**

As we have passed our 70<sup>th</sup> year the demands for maintaining the building are increasing.

We recently covered all the rooflights which were prone to leaking in severe weather.

You will probably have noticed that we had the surface replaced from the main door down to the overflow area and also had the side of the building covered, so you can now drive around the building.

This was part of the arrangement with the OPW for allowing them to use our overflow area as the base for flood relief work behind our premises.
